

# Who funds Centre for Cities?

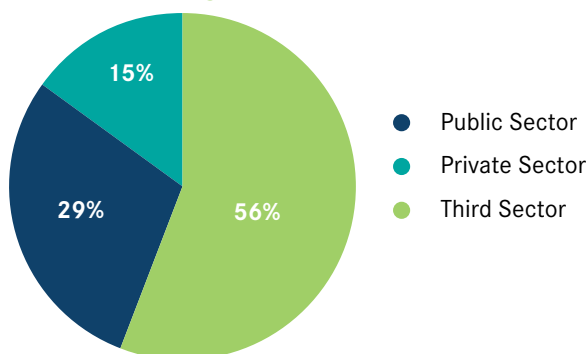
## 2015
