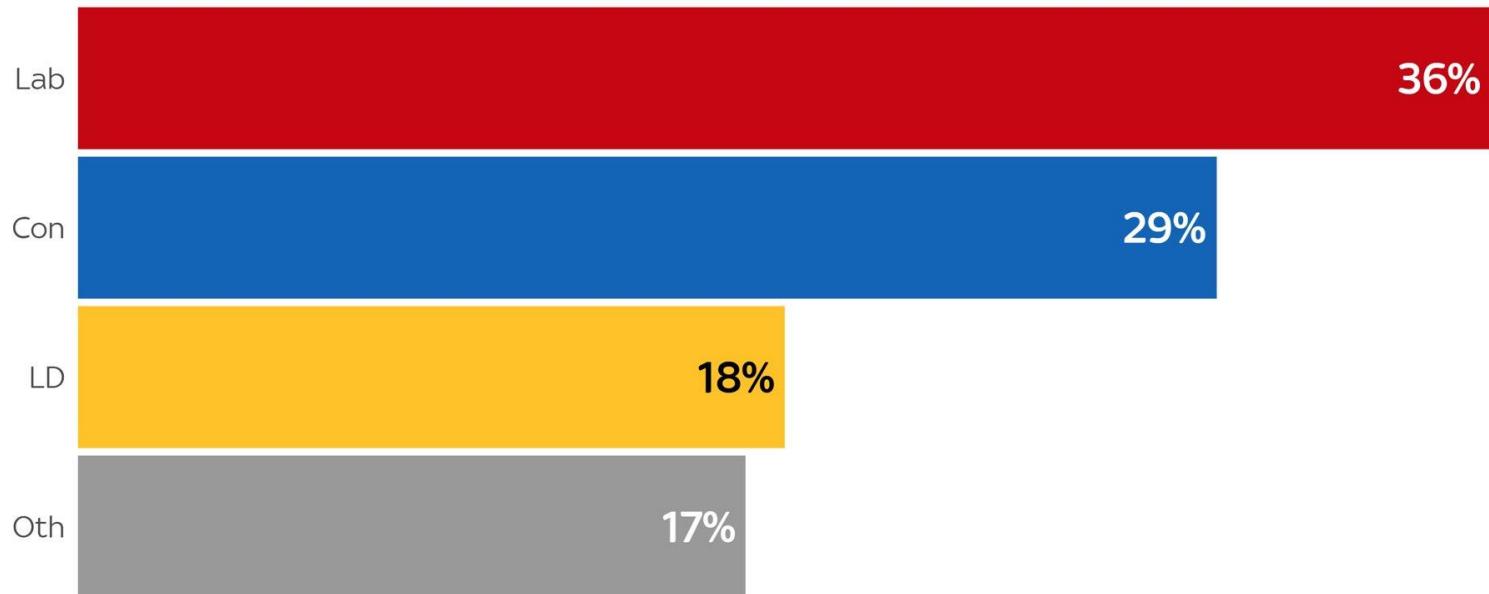

NATIONAL ESTIMATED VOTE SHARE

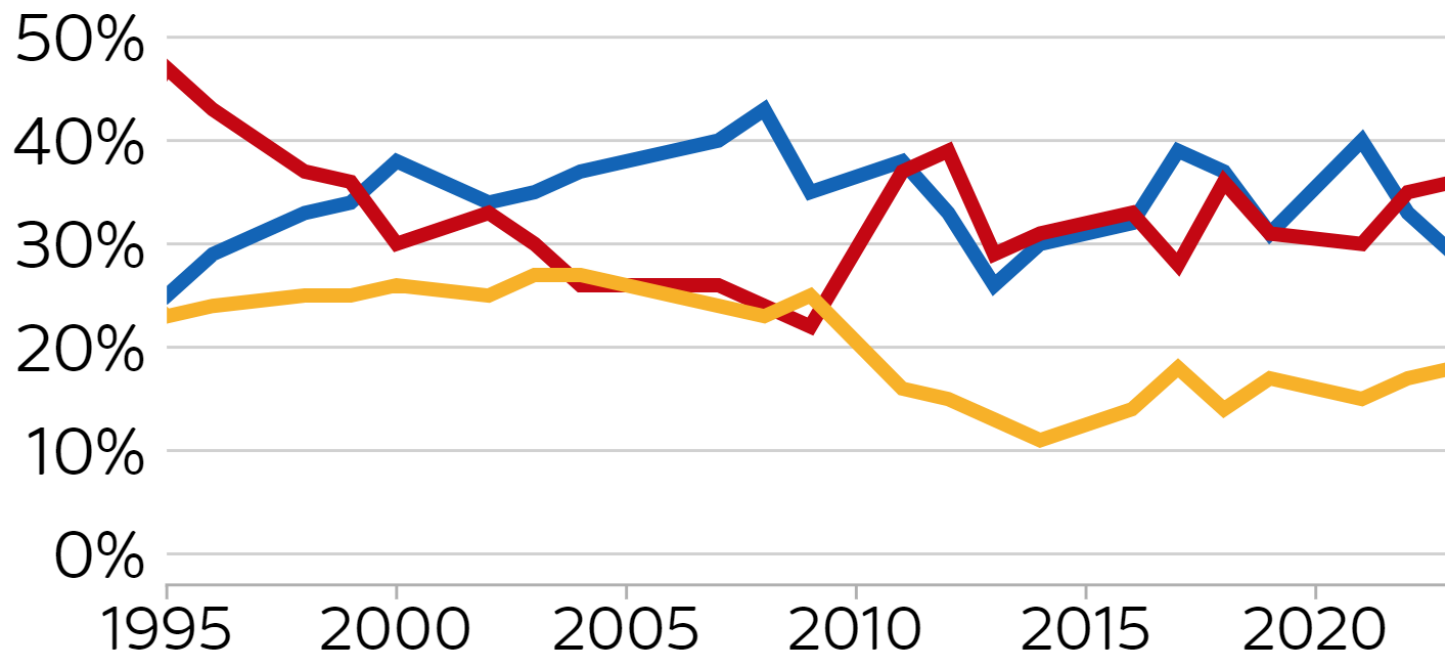
After 3 million votes across 1,500 wards

National Equivalent Vote

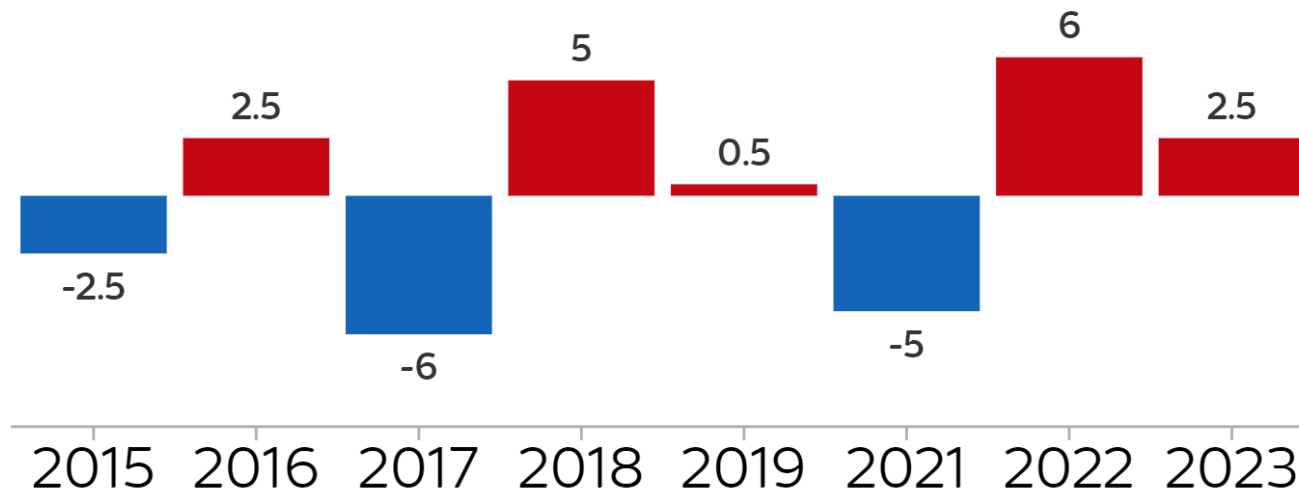
Vote share at local elections for major parties

Smaller swing to Labour than in 2022

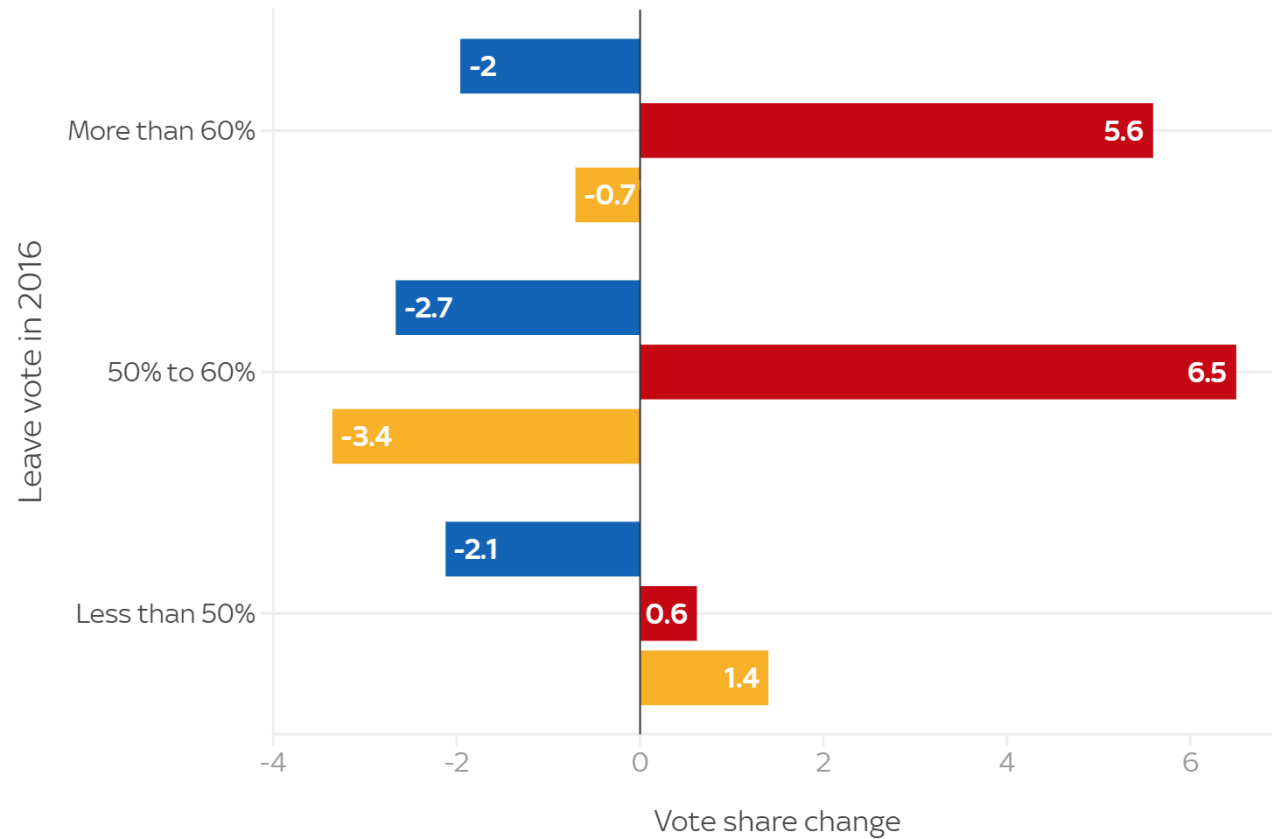
Conservative to Labour swing in the 'National Equivalent Vote'

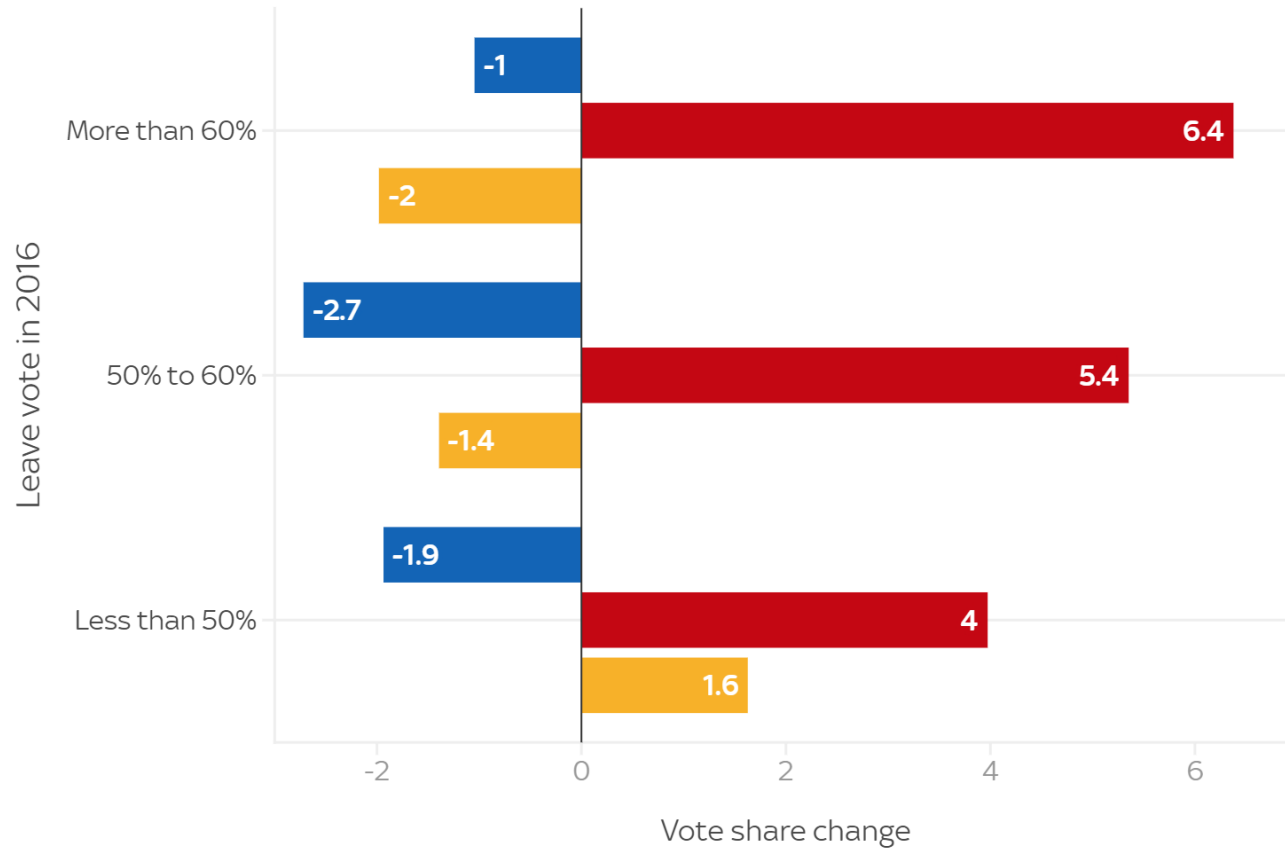
Vote share change by Brexit vote in 2016

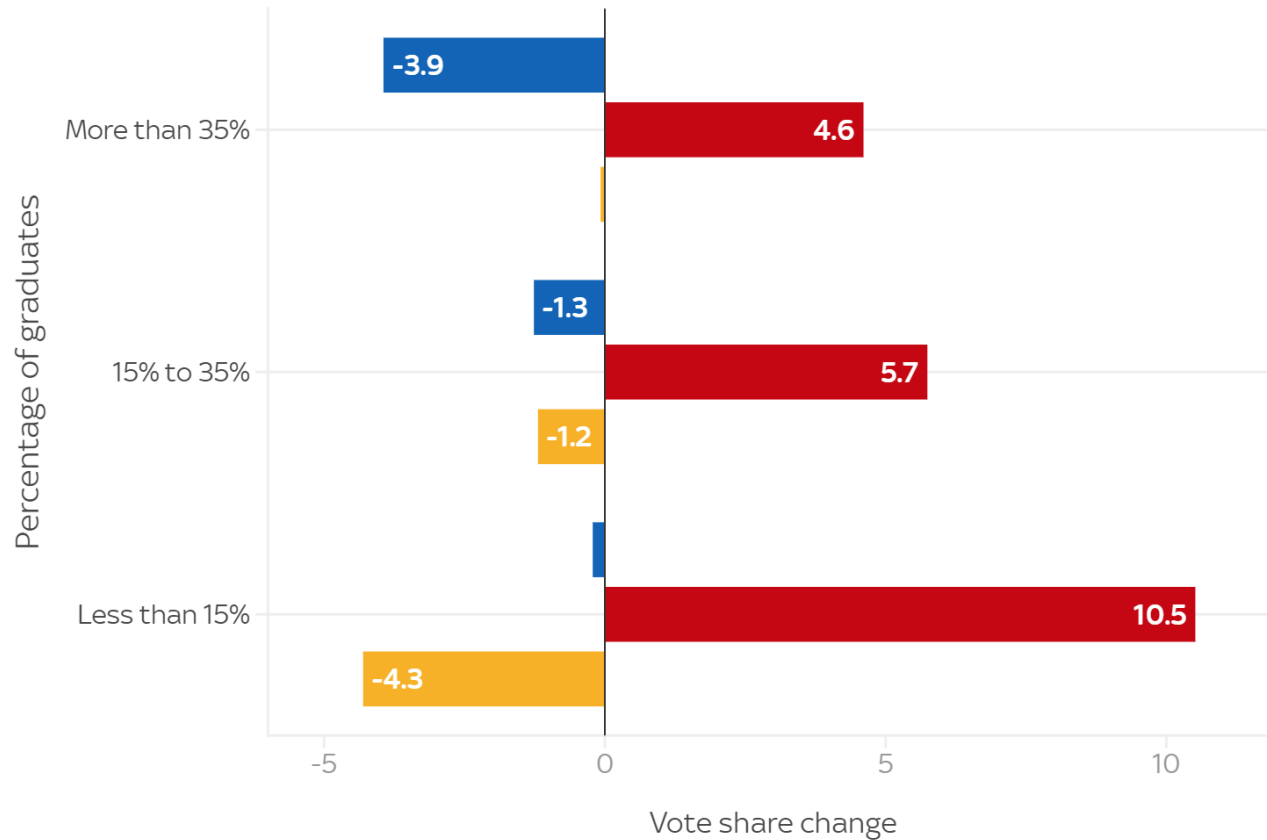
Vote share change by Brexit vote in 2016 (local authority level)



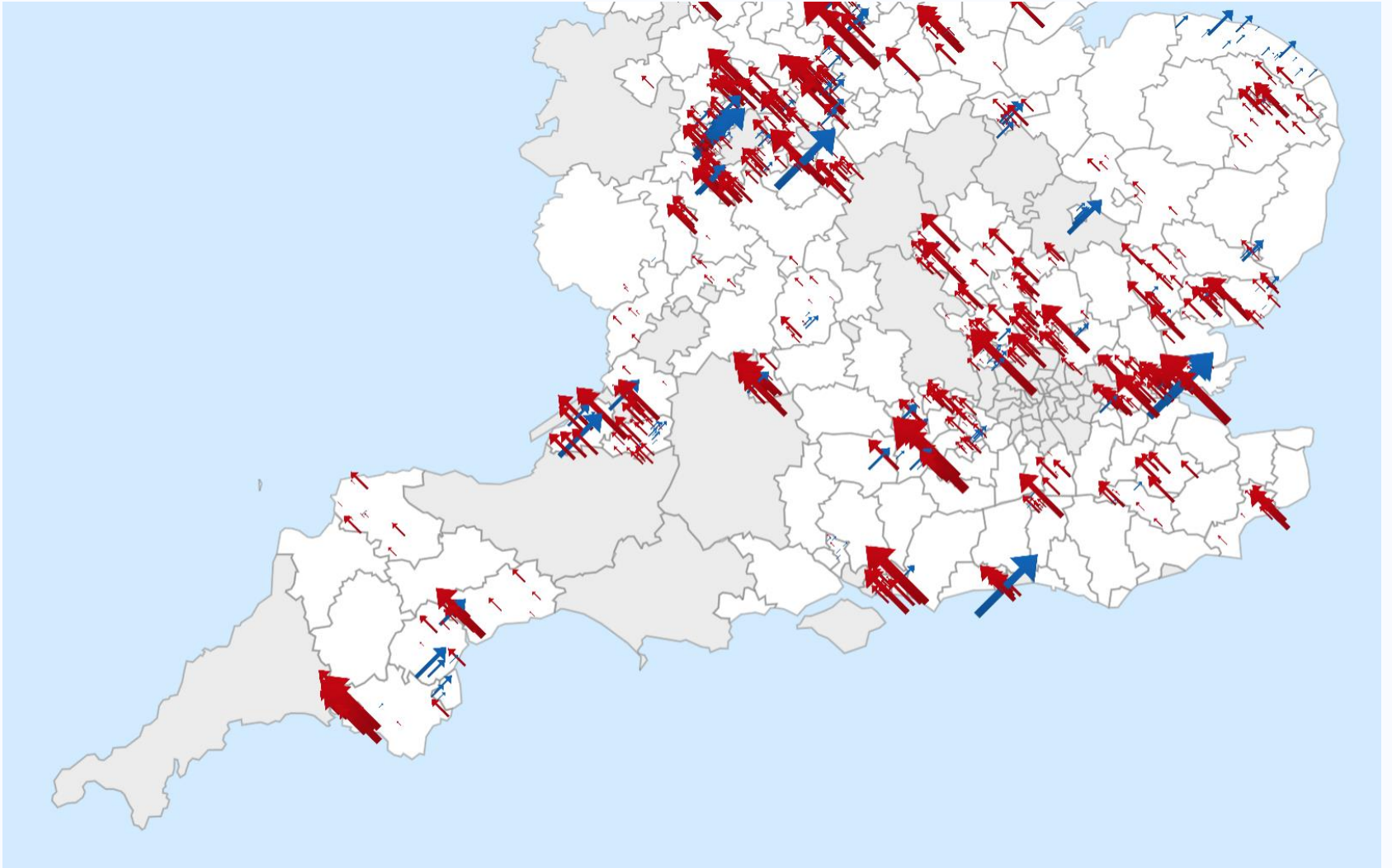

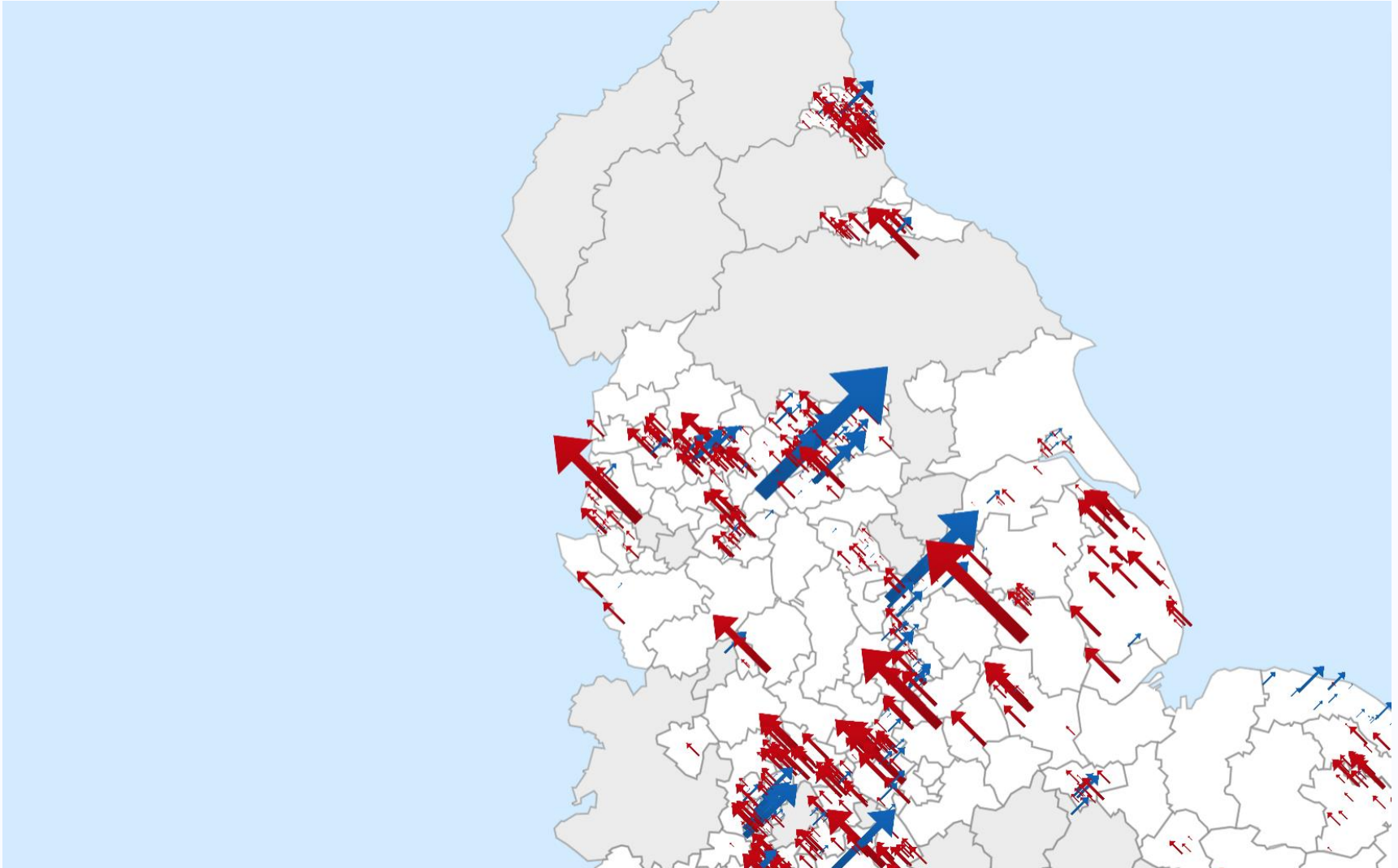
Labour did best in areas with fewest graduates, Conservatives did worst in areas with most

Vote share change by education status



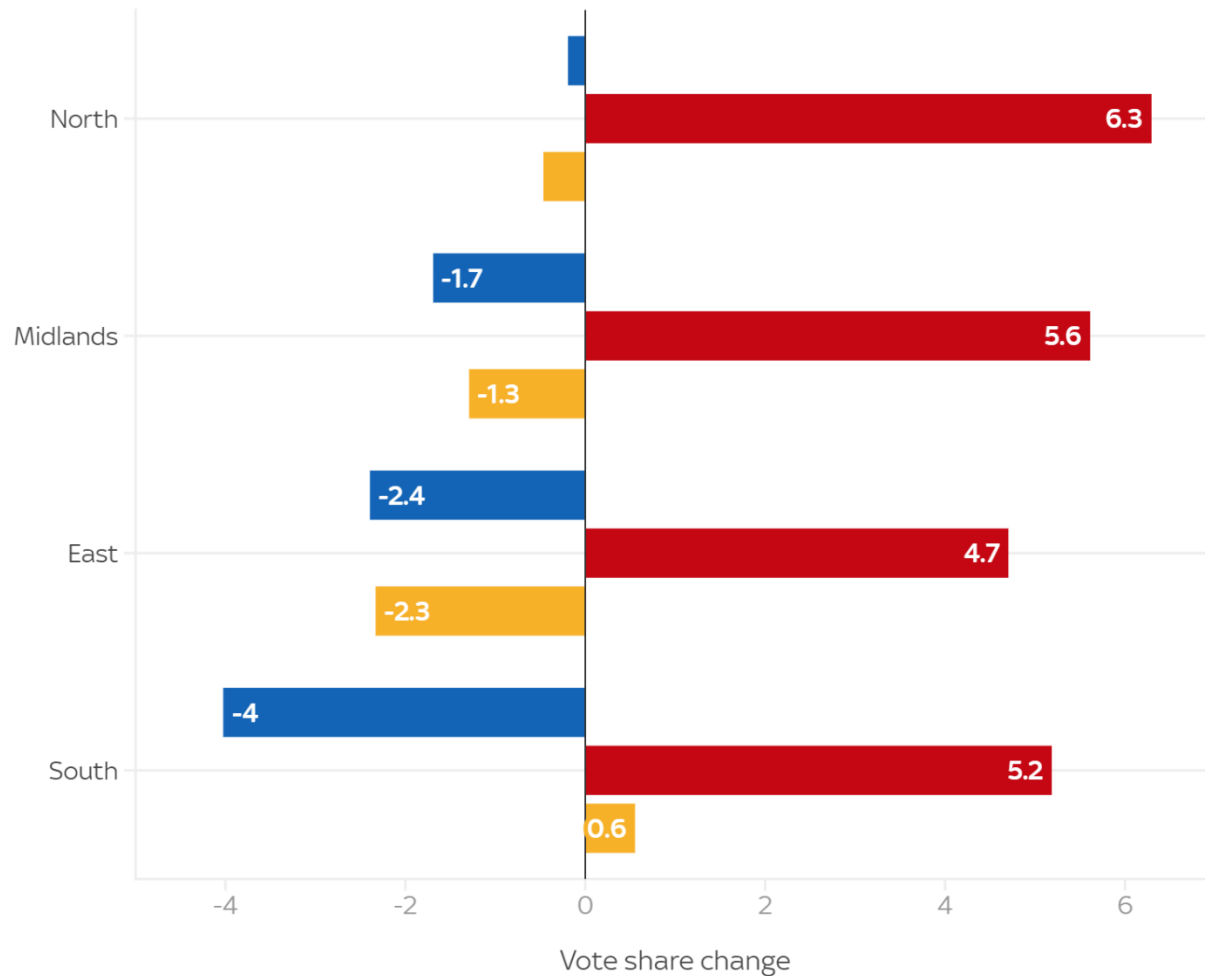

Largest swings from the Conservatives to Labour in the South

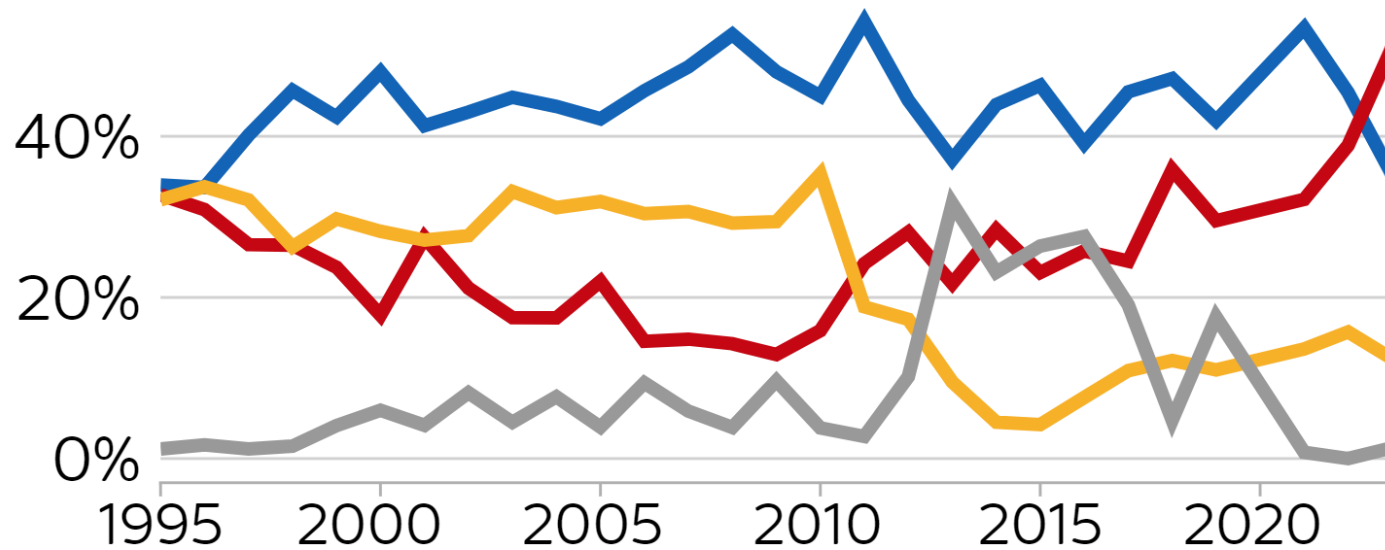
Vote share change by region

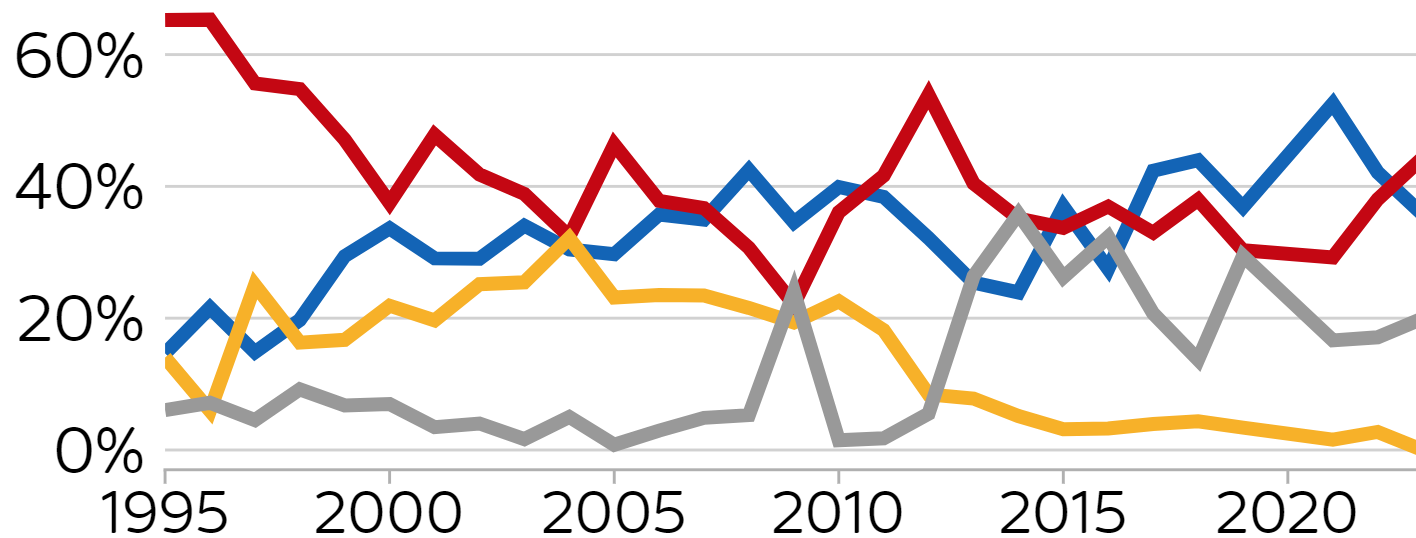
Vote share for major parties since 1995

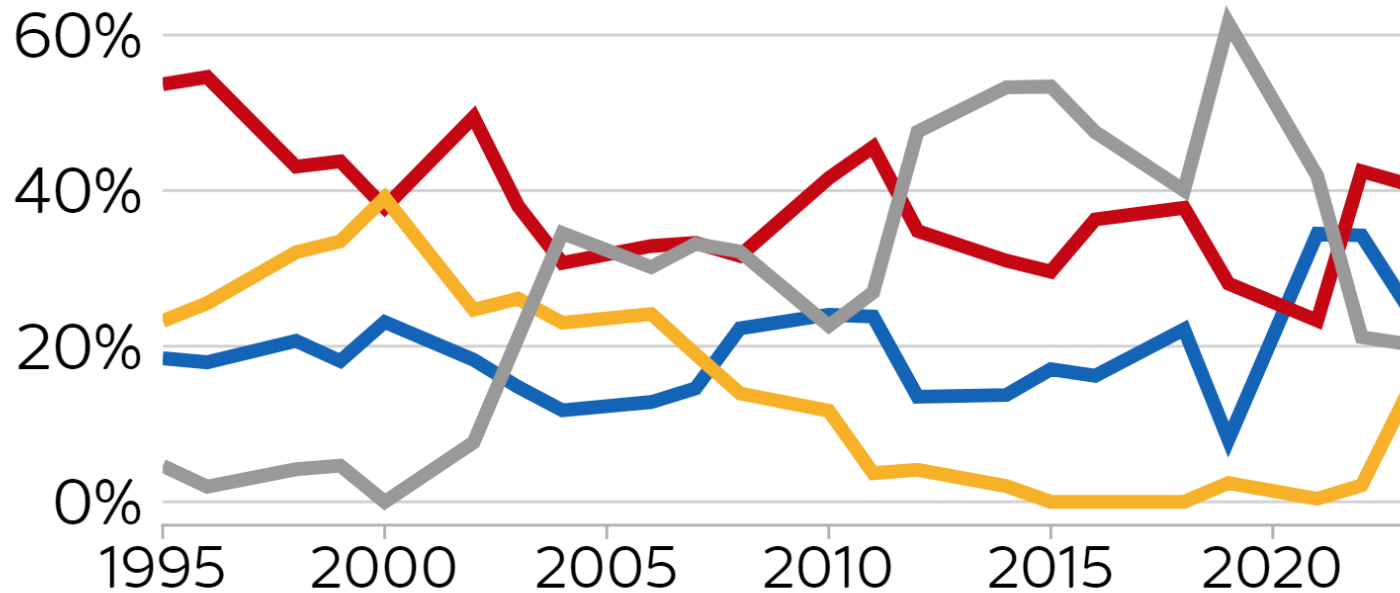
Vote share for major parties since 1995
